

How to Apply U.S. Price to Global Listings

After activating additional countries, all your items are now available for those countries but no price defined. This guide provides the steps for copying the U.S. price to your global listings.

NOTE:

- This solution is designed for sellers who would like to apply the USA price to all countries.
- We recommend to enter “Default” for the field of Shipping. Newegg will calculate shipping charges based on your pre-defined settings in Seller Portal for each country.

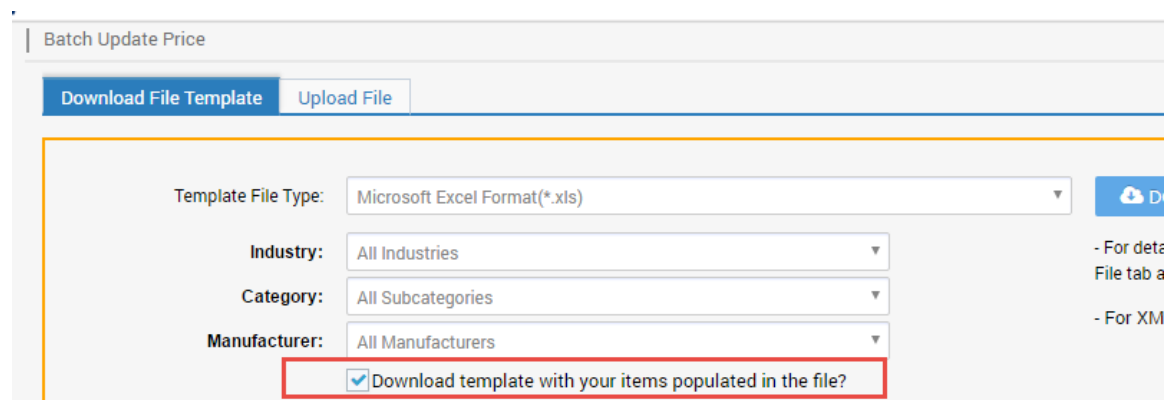
Functions:

- Seller Portal > Mange Items > Batch Update Price

How-To:

Step 1- make sure all desired countries are enabled from **Manage Account > Shipping settings**

Step 2- request a complete price report in Excel format from Seller Portal at **Manage Items > Batch Update Price**. Make sure to opt-in the option: **Download template with your items populated in the file?**



Step 3- Using Microsoft Excel to copy USA price to global listings

1. Open the Update Price file downloaded from Seller Portal.
2. Copy the Seller Part # and USA price to separate sheet, for example, Sheet 1.

- Under the Sheet 1, only keep Seller Part # and Selling Price

Instructions BatchPriceUpdate Sheet1

- Go back to the original sheet: BatchPriceUpdate then using the MS Excel function: **VLOOKUP** for Selling Price: **=VLOOKUP(A3,Sheet1!\$A\$2:\$B\$1189,2,false)**
- The VLOOKUP will reference the US price by Seller Part # based on the data on Sheet 1.

H3 : **=VLOOKUP(A3,Sheet1!\$A\$2:\$B\$1189,2,false)**

Function Arguments

VLOOKUP

Lookup_value: A3 = "NE-CVAFB-E435"

Table_array: Sheet1!\$A\$2:\$B\$1189 = ("NE-CVAFB-E435";"92.08";"NE-CVADP-"

Col_index_num: 2 = 2

Range_lookup: false = FALSE

Looks for a value in the leftmost column of a table, and then returns a value in the same row from a column you specify. By default, the table must be sorted in an ascending order.

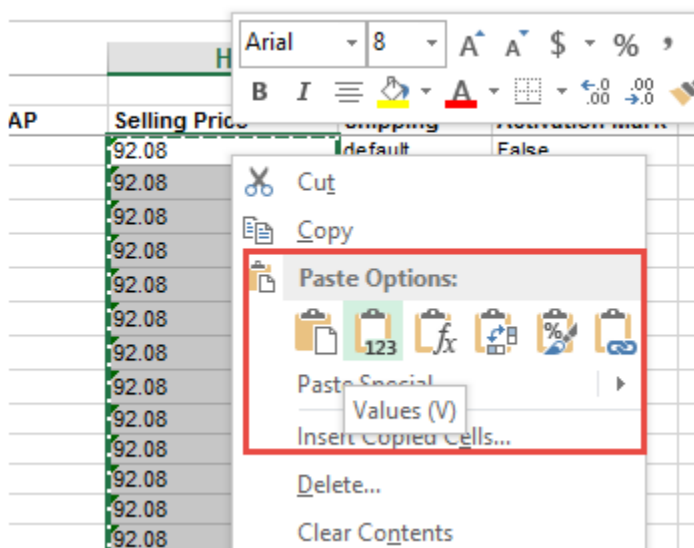
Range_lookup is a logical value: to find the closest match in the first column (sorted in ascending order) = TRUE or omitted; find an exact match = FALSE.

Formula result = 92.08

- Run the same formula to all records then the Selling Price for all other countries will be updated.
- To avoid data feed process error, the price has to be converted to regular number from the formula result. To do so, select all Selling Price for all items. Right click on the selection then click

Copy. Again, select all Selling Price for all items then right-click on any of the selected record then select paste option as “Value”. Once this is done, all data will be converted from formula to value.



8. Make sure the currency code for all items are changed to “USD”. In this way, all selling price will be converted to the local currency of each country by Newegg system.
9. Save the file then upload it to Seller Portal or FTP to enable items for multiple countries. Please reference the following example for more details.
